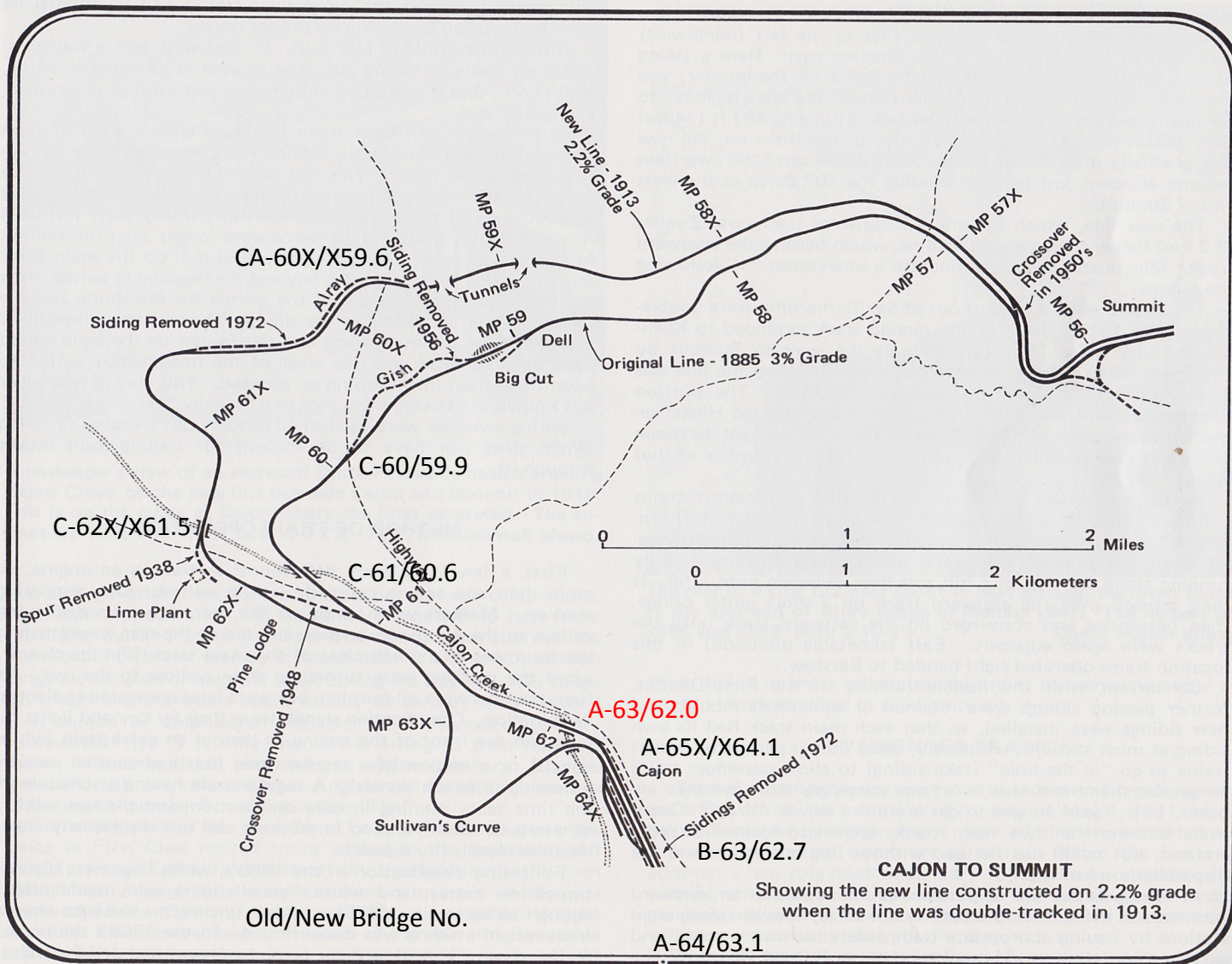

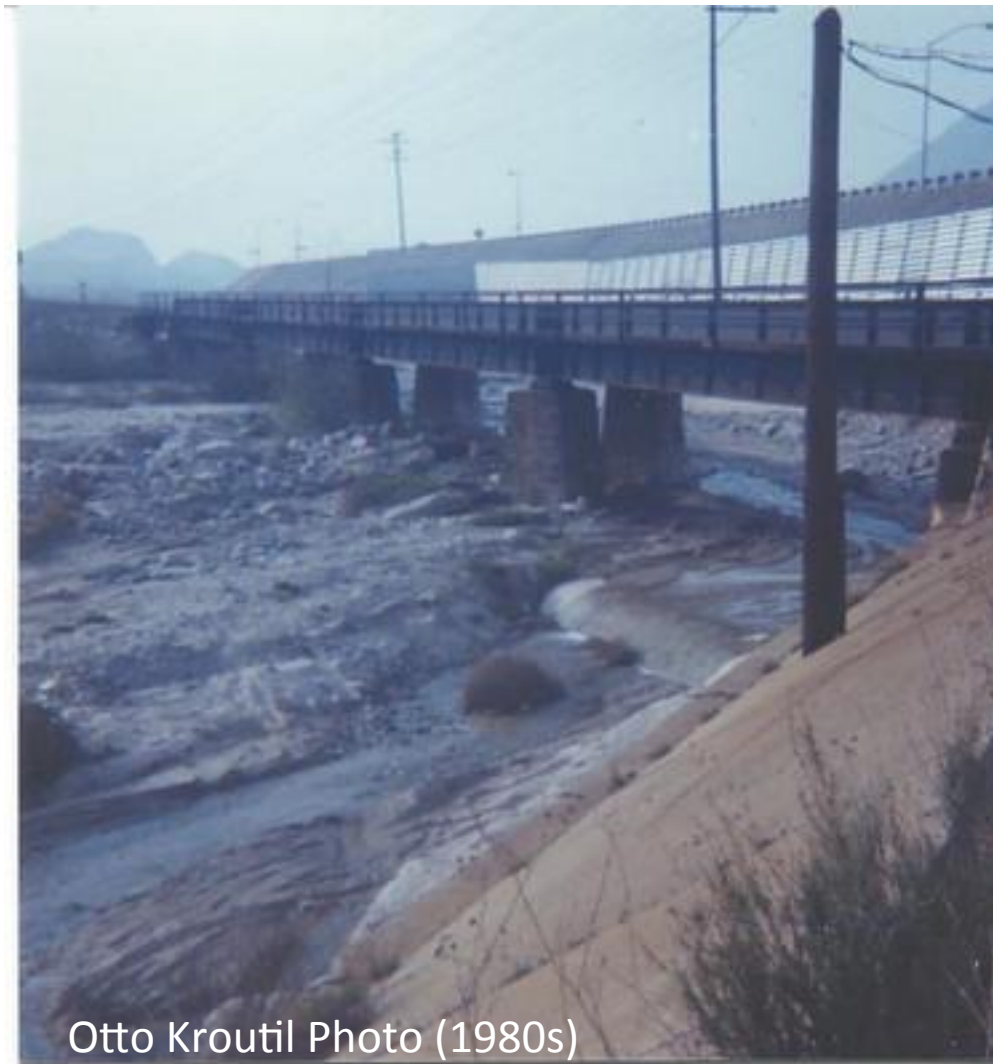








1944 Delano Photo? Shows revetment between bridges east of Cajon Station
