

NOTES ON THE CAJON PASS MOTIVE POWER INDEX

Several years ago I undertook to compile a list of the motive power which travelled through California's Cajon Pass. Consequently I had to rely upon photographic evidence which is readily available to the public. I would also wish to thank Michael Davis for his contribution taken from the book, "Union Pacific in the Los Angeles Basin" by Jeff S. Asay.

The primary purpose of this exercise was to establish the period in which various locomotives were photographed hauling themselves and their loads over "the hill". Others may deduce secondary uses for this index such as locating photographs of a specific locomotive. Whatever use you may find for it, I hope it's recognised that this labour of love also potentially comes with its faults and foibles.

A Caveat Emptor: No doubt errors or inconsistencies will emerge under more critical eyes than mine. For example, if some locomotive model types seem incorrect it is an honest mistake based upon either upon a printed caption, or ignorance on my part, or both. In some cases, the quality of some photographs also make any absolute identification difficult. Consequently in such cases these have been indicated by highlighting it in ***bold blue*** italicised text. Also if a "?" is shown beside an entry it is indicative of a similar problem. I figured this approach was better than making misleading guesses. You can make your own determination on such obscurities.

A list of the relevant abbreviations used in this Index is to be found in "Abbreviations" on pages (ii—v).

Some of the photographs used in one publication may have been repeated in other books. You may be able to spot these where the entries are exactly identical except for the publication's abbreviation. Where this has occurred, I have listed the subsequent occurrences beneath the first reference.

The list of publications I used in sourcing this index is by no means exhaustive. It merely represents the publications I have in my possession. Nonetheless, I have compiled over 4000 entries in three main categories:

- Railroad related books,
- Railroad related magazines and
- Railroad photograph catalogs.

For whatever purpose you are searching through this index, I hope you find it.
